Integrated Turn-Key Credentialing Program

ExamWorks:

- · deploys primary source verification to credential each evaluator;
- enrolls each evaluator in the Continuous Query (CQ) service of the National Practitioner Data Bank (NPDB); and
- assures that evaluators undergo credentials verification in compliance with applicable URAC standards.

Evaluators are required to complete ExamWorks' comprehensive credentialing packet, which includes attestations on conflict of interest, a confidentiality agreement with HIPAA acknowledgement, and credentialing and re-credentialing forms and related materials.

Upholding the Integrity of IME Services

ExamWorks' Credentialing Committee requires signed attestations with written explanations to any affirmative responses in the following areas:

- License limitations, suspensions, revocations or sanctions
- Hospital privileges limitations, suspensions, revocations or sanctions
- Disciplinary actions

- Felony and misdemeanor convictions
- Narcotics license suspensions and/or revocations
- Malpractice history
- Personal history of substance abuse
- Personal history of mental health issues

In the event of any adverse action, the ExamWorks Credentialing Committee - with full expert medical-legal representation - examines the evaluator's submitted credentialing information and the circumstances surrounding the adverse action. Proof of current, valid and unrestricted licensure to practice and full credentialing or re-credentialing status is required for continuance on the panel and/or panel admission.
